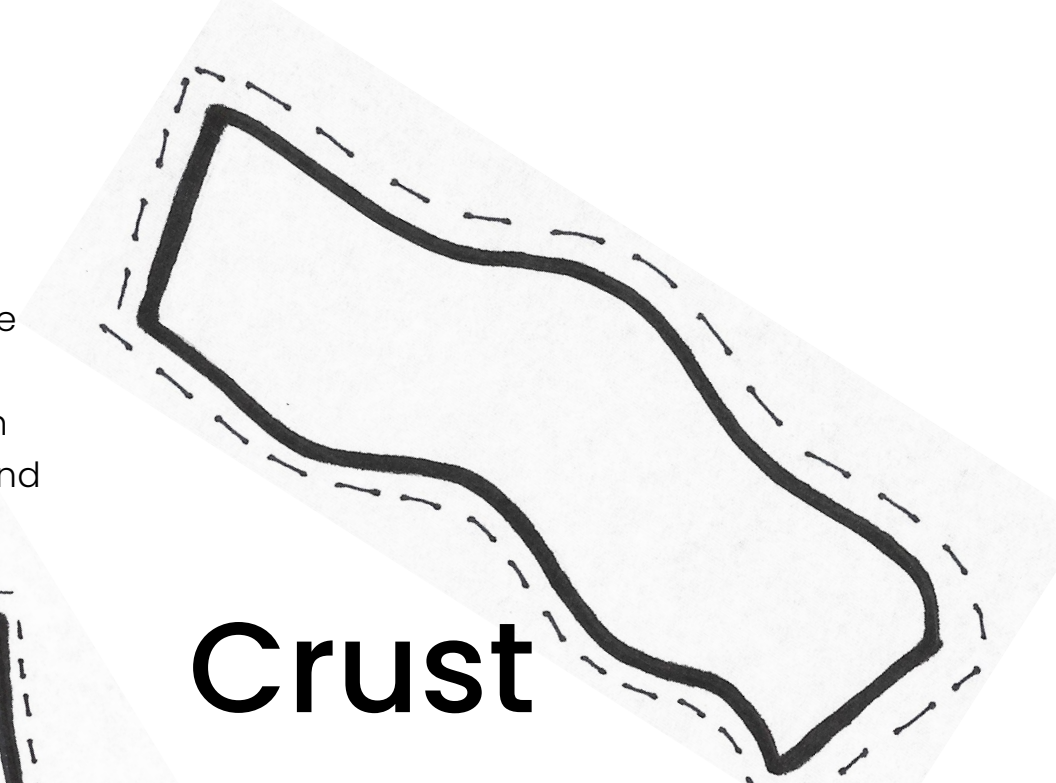


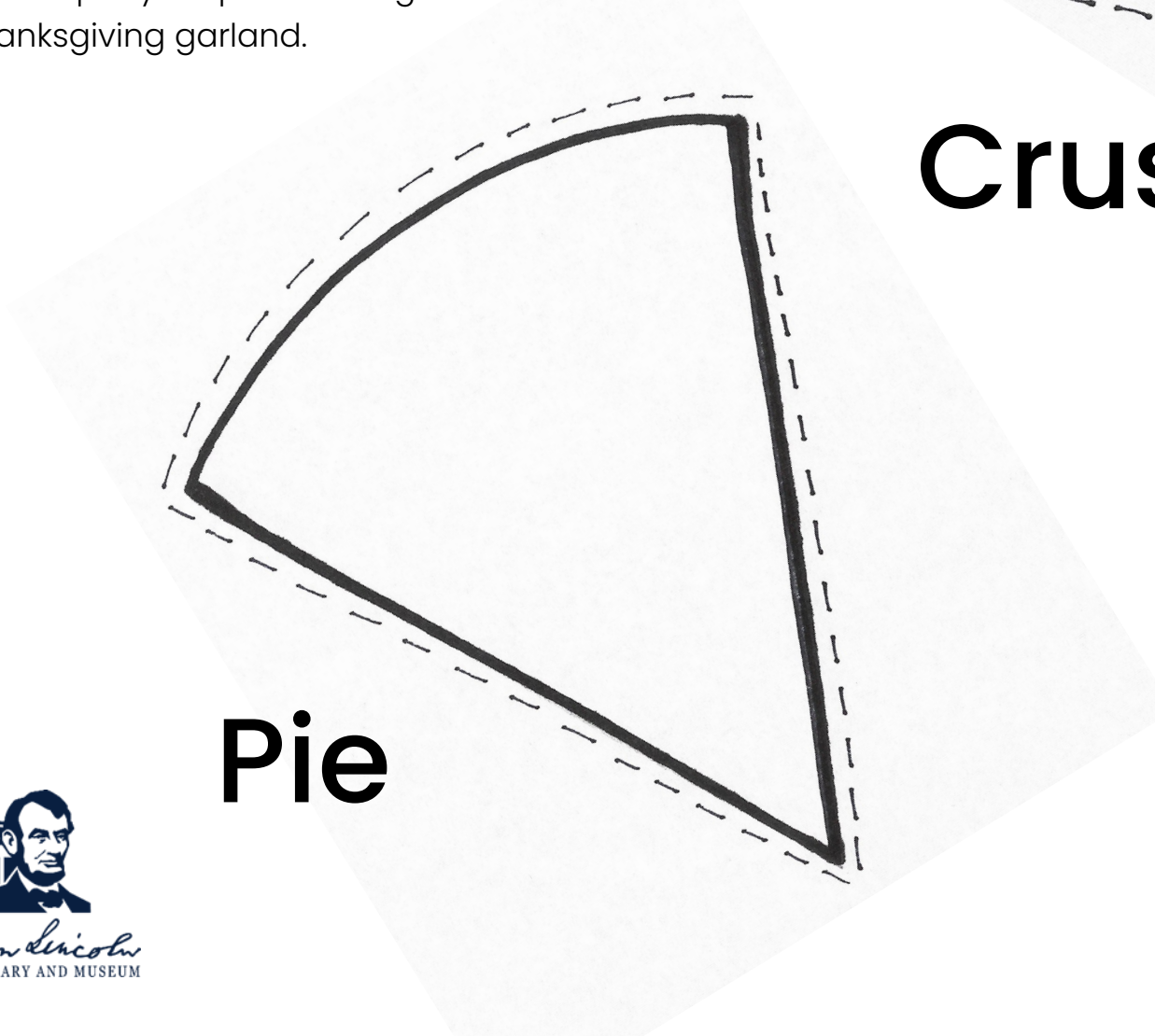

Pumpkin Pie Garland

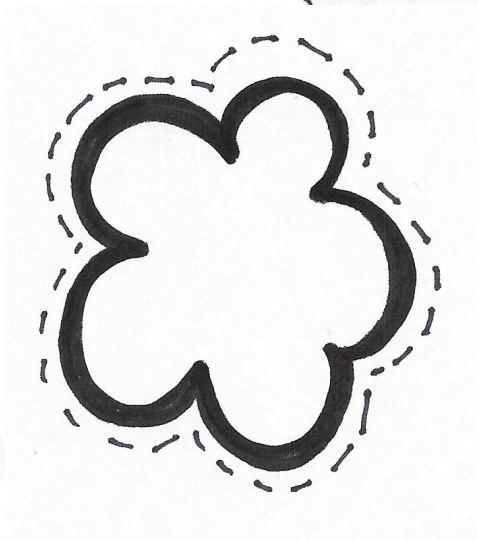
Grab a grown-up to help you make some delicious decorations. Print the pie pieces, cut them out, and trace them on heavy paper. Then cut those pieces and glue them together. Color and decorate your pie. Hole punch the sides and put your pie on string to create a sweet and stylish Thanksgiving garland.

Pie



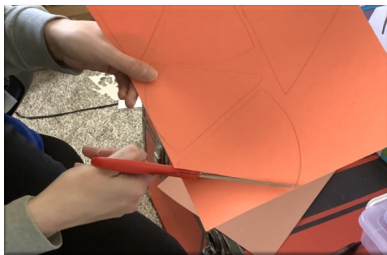
Cream

You will need:

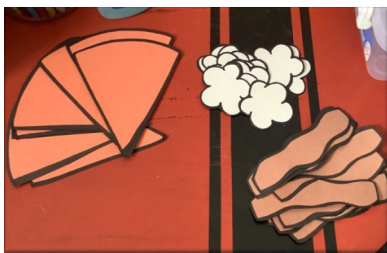
- Pie stencils (page one)
- Scissors
- Glue stick or Elmer's Glue
- Hole punch
- Yarn, twine, or ribbon
- Markers, crayons, colored pencils
- Heavy paper



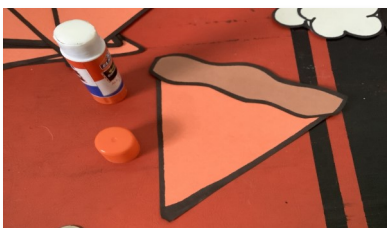
Step One: Print the pie piece template, cut out the shapes, and trace on paper.



Step Two: Carefully cut out the pie pieces. Ask a grown up to help.



Step Three: Get all of your pie pieces together. Make as many as you want for an extra long garland!



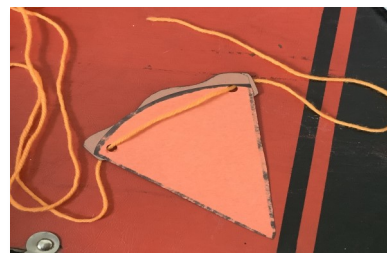
Step Four: Glue your crusts (squiggles) onto the pie (triangle).



Step Five: Glue your whipped cream (cloud shape) onto the pie.



Step Six: Carefully hole punch both sides of your pie crust. Ask a grown up to help.



Step Seven: Thread your yarn, twine, or ribbon through the holes of your pie.



Step Eight: Ask your grown up to hang up your garland and have a Happy Thanksgiving!
